



Schedule of Harbour Dues and Charges 2018/19

Under the Harbours Act 1964 & The Hayle Harbour Act 1989

ALL VESSELS ENTERING THE JURISDICTION OF THE HARBOUR MUST PAY DUES AS SET OUT BELOW

1. Mooring Licence

All vessels £20.83 (£25inc VAT)

2. Harbour dues

2.1. Pleasure vessels not engaged in trade and all vessels in layup at Lelant Saltings

Period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019. No part payment possible

£38.35 per meter per annum. (£46.02inc VAT)

All wall moorings will be charged out at a minimum of 6m

2.2. Pleasure vessels residing on pontoon moorings

Period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019. No part payment possible

£54.79 per meter per annum. (£65.75inc VAT)

All pontoon moorings will be charged out at a minimum of 6m

2.3. Registered commercial and registered fishing vessels

This will be paid in two instalments payable on 1st April & 1st October. No part payment possible.

£54.79 per meter per annum. (£65.75inc VAT)

All wall moorings will be charged out at a minimum of 6m

2.4. Visiting registered commercial and registered fishing vessels short term dues

2.5. Dues for visiting pleasure vessels not engaged in trade

2.6. Dues for sheltering local vessels by arrangement with the Harbour Master

All sheltering vessels should give at least 1 days notice to the Harbour Office. Vessels over 20m OAL must give 7days notice before entering the harbour.

3. Slipway

3.1. Visiting slipway launching including car parking

This charge is for a single vessel, vehicle and trailer. Launch & recovery.

£12.50 (£15inc VAT)

3.2. Season slipway tickets

Available from the harbour office.

<10m £120.83 (£145inc VAT)



4. Dry Birthing

£7/m PCM (£8.40inc VAT) minimum charge of one month.

All dry birthing will be under Licence, to be signed before birthing commences. Location will be allocated by the Harbour Master.

5. Car Parking

Mooring Holders £22.08per annum (£26.50inc VAT)

Non-mooring holders £43.33per annum (£52inc VAT)

Day Visitors please use the Pay & Display meters

6. Mooring Application

A non-returnable charge of £16.66 (£20inc VAT) will be payable upon completion of a Mooring Application form. This does not guarantee you a mooring allocation.

7. Crane Operations

Crane Operations £16.67 (£20inc VAT) per lift.

All cranaage to be approved by the harbour office before cranaage can take place.

8. Administration Charge

All harbour dues are subject to a £8.33(£10inc VAT) admin fee.

9. Call Out Charges

Harbour Staff call outs for non-emergencies. Will be charged at £25/hour (£30/hour inc VAT) per staff member.

It is the responsibility of the owner or skipper of any vessel brought within the jurisdiction of Hayle Harbour to pay appropriate harbour dues.

Harbour dues will be charged at the daily rate for every day a vessel is in the harbour, unless arrangements are made with the Harbour Office to pay on an annual, monthly or weekly

Failure to pay Harbour dues may result in vessels being impounded until all outstanding dues have been paid.

Hayle Harbour Act Part IV Paragraph 43 states "If the owner of any vessel shall at any time evade, or attempt to evade, payment of any charges payable by such owner to the Company at the time when the same shall become due and payable, he shall be liable to pay to the Company a sum of £20 or a sum equal to three times the amount of such charges (whichever shall be the greater), which sum shall be a debt due to the Company."
