2 Aids to Navigation

The North cardinal buoy dragged its moorings during the January storms and was eventually washed ashore when the mooring chain parted.

The buoy was disassembled on the beach and recovered to the harbour.

A new top mark light and chain has been ordered; once the buoy is reassembled the plan is for the Padstow dredger to return the buoy onto station.

3 MV John Martin

The harbour owners have instructed the Authority to obtain quotes for the vessel to be lifted out onto the quay where it will be broken up.

4 CCTV

The system has now been installed and provides 75% coverage of the harbour. As funds become available additional cameras will be installed to provide complete coverage. The Harbour Authority is also looking at the possibility of placing a camera on the upper leading light to provide coverage of the bar and North cardinal buoy.
